



BERETTA CONFIRMED IN SEVEN'S EXPANDED B12HR COVERAGE

(Monday, 9 November, 2015) SUNRISE sports presenter, Bathurst 1000 host, and experienced pit lane reporter Mark Beretta will return to host Seven's coverage of the 2016 Liqui-Moly Bathurst 12 hour next February.

A veteran of Seven's motorsport coverage over two decades, and an acknowledged motorsport enthusiast, Beretta will be the head-up the broadcast team that includes the return of the renowned radiolemans.com crew from Europe – the global voices of Sports Car and GT racing.

"I totally enjoyed every minute of my time in pit lane this year, and there was no way I was going to miss it in 2016!" he said.

The Seven Network confirmed that they will once again show all twelve hours of the 2016 race live and free around Australia with a final breakdown of coverage between Seven and 7mate to be finalised.
