Following the success of the first three-part series, which launched last spring, **Back to the Land** will return as a 12-part series to celebrate rural Britain through championing the UK's most inspirational rural entrepreneurs.

Kate, who started her own business in the countryside a few years ago, will bring her insight, passion and knowledge of rural life to unpack the unique tales and celebrate some of their most joyous and successful moments with their families and friends.

Kate Humble says: "I'm delighted that we are going to be making another series. The stories of people who had taken risks, tried new things, been brave and innovative in order to create ways of making a living that they believed in, inspired and delighted not just the audience, but the whole production team and I! All of us can't wait to get started again. This might be the beginning of a counter industrial revolution that sees everyone wanting to head Back to the Land!"

At its heart, it's a stylish factual format, which touches on elements of history, geography and tradition.
