Australia's number one drama to return in 2014

Seven commissions a second series of A Place to Call Home

Channel Seven today announced its critically acclaimed drama *A Place to Call Home* has been commissioned for a second series.

The number one new drama of 2013 – which premiered to a national audience of 2.6 million* people – has been a huge hit amongst critics and audiences alike.

Brad Lyons, Director of Network Production, said the decision reaffirmed Seven's commitment to local drama. "A Place to Call Home has showcased drama on a scale never seen before on Australian television," he said. "It's pleasing to see such an ambitious production receive the acclaim it deserves."

Australians have been completely swept away by the 1950s drama created by Bevan Lee for the Seven Network.

"The story of *A Place to Call Home* is far from told by the end of series one," Bevan stated. "So I am thrilled we are able to continue the saga of Sarah Adams and the Bligh family in a second compelling season, thanks to the show being enthusiastically embraced by our fans."

Pre-production on season two is already under way with shooting to commence later this year.
