



Seven secures Australian football marquee match

18 February 2014 -- Football Federation Australia (FFA) has today announced that the Seven Network has acquired the broadcast rights to the Foxtel A-League All Stars v Italian Serie A giants Juventus at ANZ Stadium in Sydney in August.
